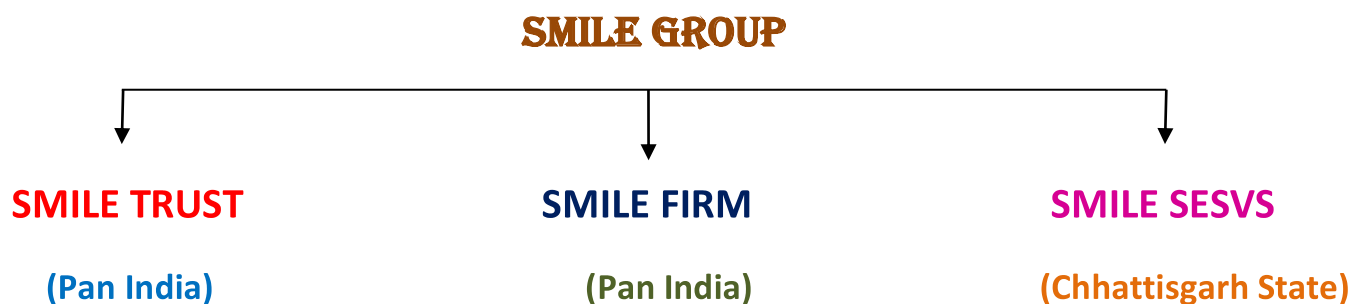


–: Annual Activity Report :– (2020-21)



Preamble: -

On the completion of 10 years of working of SMILE; we are very proud to present our activity report for the year 2020-21.

The shift towards SMILE Group from SMILE SESVS took the shape as we could initiate programs under all our 3 entities; and it gave us the privilege to reach out to more people through various escalated services PAN INDIA.

We take up the opportunity to thank our Supports, Donors and all the Stakeholders for keeping their trust in SMILE during all these years.

We were challenged to start this year in the midst of Chaos due to nationwide lockdown. We were facing over crowded villages due to reverse migration, job loss along with less versed medical, administrative and infrastructural support system to combat CORONA. SMILE has been given the place at Chhattisgarh State Government's Portal "Corona Help Desk" under which we were extensively engaged in information dissemination along with channelizing facilities like Oxygen Concentrator, Oxygen Cylinders, Ambulances, Blood Plasma, Food, Vegetables and other facilities through **SMILE Volunteers** and **SMILE 24 hours help line number**.

Our trainings on Livelihood, Health & Hygiene Awareness along with Developmental Trainings took a paradigm shift from physical to ON - LINE. Our supply and SHG productions were affected adversely as the market remained closed for a long duration. We encouraged all our SHGs to focus on Health Safety and SMILE went on exploring the survival opportunity for the SHGs during the pandemic while involving them into production of Masks, Hand Sanitizers, Soap, Phenyl, Toilet Cleaner etc. SMILE channelized orders of Masks, Hand Sanitizers, Soap and Phenyl from Government Departments and also from the private firms. SMILE SHGs widely distributed **Free Face Masks**.

April 2020:-

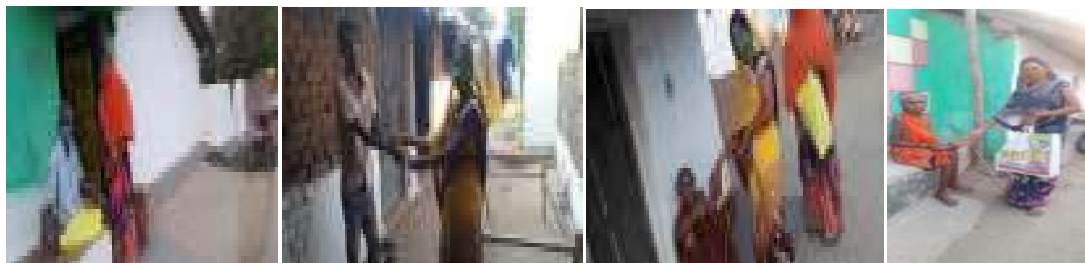
a) Livelihood and Health: - SLDP & SHSP.

We organized trainings on Hand Wash and Respiratory Hygiene in the villages of Bagbahara block of Mahasamund district, we also channelized orders for making masks, hand sanitizers, Phenyl and soap from Government departments along with other firms to our SHGs to ensure livelihood in the midst of Covid Chaos along with raising awareness on Personal and Respiratory Hygiene. We also distributed FREE Masks to the villagers.

b) Ration and Vegetable Distribution: - SSDP

Ration and Vegetables were distributed to the needy as the shops and markets were closed due to lockdown.

SHGs motivated villagers and business people to contribute Ration and Vegetables to the needy people of the villages.



Ration and vegetables were packed, needy people were enlisted and then the distribution was done.



c) Vermicompost and Kanda Making: - SLDP

Vermicompost pits were established in different villages. Vermicompost was sold to the Horticulture Department and at farmers for growing vegetables.

महासमुद्र (2 मई 2020) जिसे के 55 मौजान खानो में 01 जून 2020 से 11 मई 2020 तक खरी बंध उपरिपर 55 मौजान खानो के महिला स्व-सहायता समूह द्वारा 704.25 मिटरल जैविक खाद, वही कमपोस्ट खाद का उत्पादन किया जा चुका है। जिससे 145.20 मिटरल खाद का बिक्रय महिला समूह द्वारा उदरनिर्जीक बिक्रय एवं का बिक्रय को कर एक लाख 05 हजार 700 रुपय की 38मदुमी अर्जित कर चुके है। कृषि विभाग के उपसंचालक श्री दत्त,जय, डोंगरी ने बताया कि महासमुद्र बिक्रयखंड के प्रमुख मौजान खान में से बरसाही में 08 मीटरल, बदीरवा में 05 मीटरल, सोना में 08 मिटरल, खड़ी में (6 मिटरल, बरौणखाना में 02 मिटरल खली खाद बिक्रय के लिए उपलब्ध है। इसी तरह बरसाही बिक्रयखंड के खान जैराहाई में 40 मिटरल, बरौणखानो, ताईसांड, एवं बिबारी में 08-08 मिटरल, टांगरी में 02 मिटरल, बोटगुल में 05 मिटरल, मंडोरी में 20 मिटरल, पिरांडाटार में 20.60 मिटरल, बरौणखाना खान, बरसांड एवं बोटरी टाटार में 4-4 मिटरल जैविक खाद उपलब्ध है।

इसी तरह विधीय बिक्रयखंड के खान पासवाही में 100 मिटरल उपरिपर खाद में से 40 मिटरल खाद उदरनिर्जीक बिक्रय द्वारा 34 हजार रुपय का बिक्रय किया गया। बरौणखाना में 90 मिटरल उपरिपर खाद में से 40 मिटरल खाद का अन्य उदरनिर्जीक बिक्रय द्वारा 34 हजार रुपय का बिक्रय किया गया। बीच 120 मिटरल उपलब्ध है। बरसांड बिक्रयखंड के खान महासमुद्र में 100 मिटरल उपरिपर खाद में से 40 मिटरल का अन्य उदरनिर्जीक बिक्रय द्वारा 34 हजार रुपय का बिक्रय साथ एवं 02 मिटरल खाद भी उपलब्ध है। खान आमदनी में 15 मिटरल, बरौण, बरौण, बिबिबा में 4-4 मिटरल एवं विमरौण 24 मिटरल जैविक खाद उपलब्ध है एवं 02 मिटरल का बिक्रय का एक हजार 700 रुपय अन्य स्व-सहायता समूह को प्राप्त हुआ है। इसी प्रकार बरौणखानो बिक्रयखंड के खान बरौणखानो मौजान में 20 मिटरल, बरौणखाना, पिरांडाटार, ताईसांड एवं विरगुल में 02-02 मिटरल, खली खाद उपलब्ध है। मुन, ताईसांड, बरौणखानो एवं बरौण (बिबारी) में 06-06 मिटरल जैविक खाद बिक्रय के लिए उपलब्ध है।

SHG members were not allowed to go out of the village for work so cow dung cake was made and sold to make earnings.



May 2020:-

a) Livelihood and Health: - SLDP & SHSP.

We could organized few orders of mask from Department of Forest and other departments and organizations for our SHGs at Mahasamund district and Jashpur district. Our SHGs at both the districts earned around Rs. 4,00,000 from selling the masks to departments and organizations.



b) Forest Produce Collection and sale through Co-Operative: - SLDP

Our SHGs at Jashpur district are involved in collection of Forest Produce and Sale through their Co-Operative Society.

Our SHGs are making quite good amount of earning.

On 30.05.2020, Staff Meeting was organized at Bagbahara office to evaluate the work done and for further instructions on Covid Protocol.



h) SMILE Rabbitry: - SLDP

SMILE Sulema SHG involved in Livelihood Program through Rabbitry at Jashpur District.



i) E-Shakti PIMC: - SSDP

Biofloc at Aalekhunte and Kahuwakuda were visited on 08.07.2020 and 15.07.2021 for monitoring. Required suggestions were given.



d) Health Awareness Campaign - Wall Writing: - SHSP

h) Staff Meeting: - Administration

SMILE Program Co-Ordinator; Mr. Rajesh Kripal took the meeting with Bagbahara staff emphasizing on targets and discussed the gaps in details, motivated staff to reach out to more and more needy people through our activities.



i) Godhan Naya Yojana: - SLDP

In support with state government, our SHGs took active participation in Godhan Naya Yojana at Bodridadar, Khattadih, Mohandi, Basuladabri and many more villages in Mahasamund district. Cow dung was bought from our SHGs, increasing their earnings.



j) Leadership Training: - SSDP

A leadership training was organized at Mohandi Village on 21.07.2020 for the SHG leaders to disseminate the information on Behavioural Change at the hour of Covid pandemic and how to lead the community towards better health along with Income Generation. This training was led by SMILE Program Director - Mrs. Nibha Singh, SMILE Volunteer - Mr. Ansh Chinmay Singh and Mr. Joydeep Samdhar.



August 2020:-

a) Leadership Training: - SSDP

On 02.08.2020 Leadership training was organized at Bahmani Village of Mahasamund district. SMILE Program Director - Mrs. Nibha Singh shared about the Respiratory and Personal Hygiene and SMILE CEO Mr. Jeetendra Singh emphasised on Income Generation Activities and the role of SHG women in it. 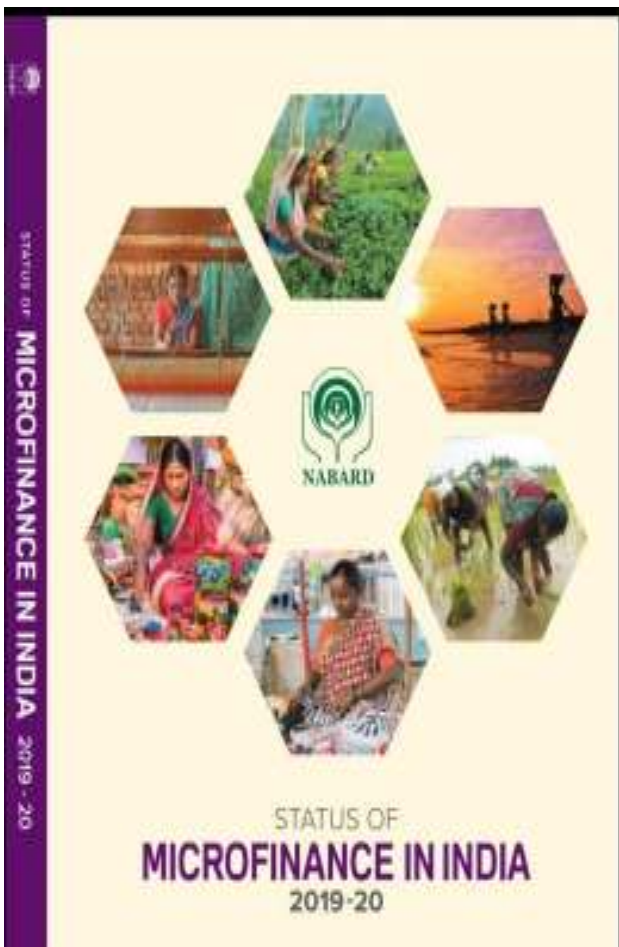
d) Sun Dried Tomato: - SLDP

f) Livelihood Trainings - Rabbitry: - SLDP

Livelihood Trainings were organized at Salhebhata on 05.09.2020 and at Bodridadar on 19.09.2020 which was attended by the SHG members who are seeking livelihood support. SMILE Program Director, Mrs. Nibha Singh assured all weather support to the SHG members for their economic sustainability.



g) Fish Farming: - SLDP

08.09.2020 SMILE Program Director Mrs. Nibha Singh visited Karridih where SMILE Parmeshwari SHG is doing fishery. She gave few valuable suggestions on feeding schedule and water parameters.



h) Ginger Farming: - SLDP

On 08.09.2020; SMILE Program Director met the members of Sharda & Sarasvati SHGs at Salhebhatha where these SHGs are growing Ginger for their Income Generation they have cultivated 10 quintals of ginger in previous crop and the same is expected for this harvest also. They were very pleased with the services of SMILE to them.



October 2020:-

a) Success Story - Goat Farming: - SLDP

SMILE Naina SHG was formed with 10 members on 01.10.2015 at Village Kasekera, Block Bagbahara, District Mahasamund of Chhattisgarh State. SMILE Naina SHG was given the opportunity to select the work they want to get involved in. Before the formation of SMILE Naina SHG few individuals were involved in agriculture and most of them were working as agriculture labor, meagerly earning 4-5 months in a year.

SMILE helped SMILE Naina SHG in Saving Linkage in Chhattisgarh Rajya Gramin Bank at Komakhan and thus savings along with internal lending started. From the beginning SMILE Naina SHG was very active and started its business by making Chunks, Till Laddu and Peanut Laddu. SMILE helped in marketing the products and awarded the SMILE Naina SHG with

incentives many times. SMILE Naina SHG was Credit Linked through NABARD E-Shakti on 25.09.2018 with Rs. 1,00,000 and started rearing Goats with investment of Rs. 20,000 in 4 goats. Every six months each female goat gave birth to 1-2 kids and in another 6 months those kids were ready to sell and gave earning of about Rs. 4000 each kid and if the goat is fully grown then it is sold for Rs. 7000 to 8000 per goat. One of the SHG member Amrika Bai has been given the responsibility of taking goats for grazing and is paid Rs. 4500 per month from the SHG.

Till now SMILE Naina SHG has earned Rs. 60,000 from selling the goats.



SMILE Naina SHG has lost nearly 10 goats till now due to diseases and the SHG has not sold any goats since lockdown thus they have quite a number of goats as asset at present. SMILE Animator Saveeta Manikpuri is looking after and doing Go-Live. Members are keen to go for Second Credit Linkage. SMILE Naina SHG is very much thankful to NABARD and SMILE for supporting their livelihood activities.

b) Rabbit Unit Delivery at Salhebhata: - SLDP

Jai Ma Sharda SHG of Salhebhata wanted to start business through rabbit unit. They have gone through the training and on 05.10.2020 one unit of rabbit was delivered with the Buy-Back contract for the sustainable livelihood.



c) E-Shakti Animator's Review Meeting: - SSDP

On 06.10.2020 Animator's review meeting was organized at SMILE Bagbahara office which was convened by DDM NABARD Mr. K.G. Manoj along with Yes Team Consultant Mr. Rekhraj Sahu in which work done was assessed and the lacunas were identified and addressed.



d) Partnering with Punjab National Bank - Farmers Training Centre (PNB-FTC): - SLDP

PNB-FTC and SMILE came together to provide Livelihood Trainings to the Farmers and SHGs in many livelihood activities like Rabbitry, Mushroom Cultivation, Fish Farming, Eatables, Washing Powder, Phenyl, Candle Making etc, rabbit cages were shifted to FTC with the objective of efficient trainings.



e) TOT on Livelihood Activities at PNB - FTC: - SLDP

From 13.10.2020 to 15.10.2020 TOT on Livelihood Activities of Animator's along with SHG members were organized at PNB-FTC. FTC Director Mr. Rajesh Kumar Dhrew welcomed all the trainees, SMILE Program Director Mrs. Nibha Singh introduced the objective of TOT. Different livelihood trainings were provided with the objective that the animator's will promote livelihood activities in the fields and support the farmers and SHGs as trainers. Mr. Abhishek Gupta from NABARD guided the trainees on record keeping. Training Assessment and Evaluation was done by SMILE Volunteer Mr. Ansh Chinmay Singh.



f) Mushroom Cultivation: - SLDP

Mushroom is being grown and sold by SMILE Jai Ma Laxmi SHG of Mahasamund district.



g) TOT - Staff Field Exposure - Biofloc: - SLDP

Staff Field Exposure in continuation to TOT was organized on 24.10.2020 at Kahuwakuda biofloc with the objective to bring more and more Farmers and SHGs into biofloc while creating the awareness on the benefits of biofloc in comparison to traditional fish farming. SMILE Executive Committee Member Mr. Sanjay Singh guided SMILE staff to take up the initiative for sustainable Livelihood for the SHGs and Farmers.



h) Innovation for Livelihood - Cow Dung Diya (lamp): - SLDP

Our SHGs creating livelihood opportunity in the midst of corona pandemic by making diyas out of cow dung and selling it at the price between Rs.2 to 5 each.



i) Livelihood raining at FTC: - SLDP

On 27.10.2020 SMILE CEO Mr. Jeetendra Singh was invited to conduct Livelihood Training for SHG representatives of Aarang Block, 3-Phase IGP was shared.
