Our advisors, consultants, members and friends were given the responsibilities to explore more funding opportunities as SMILE is in dire need of funding.

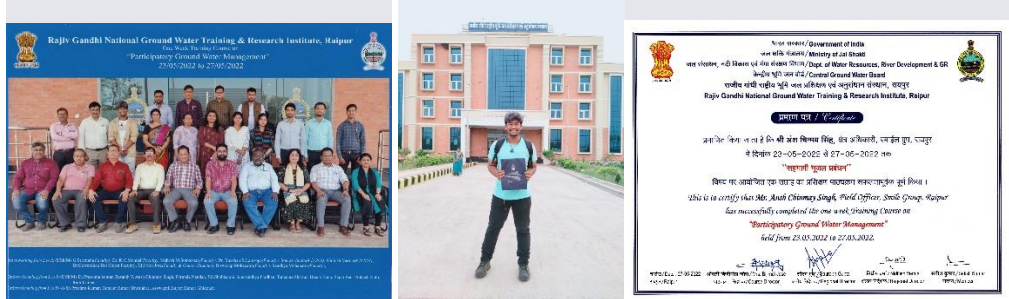
SMILE will be inviting potential prospects to be a part as members.

b) Cluster Development Program :-

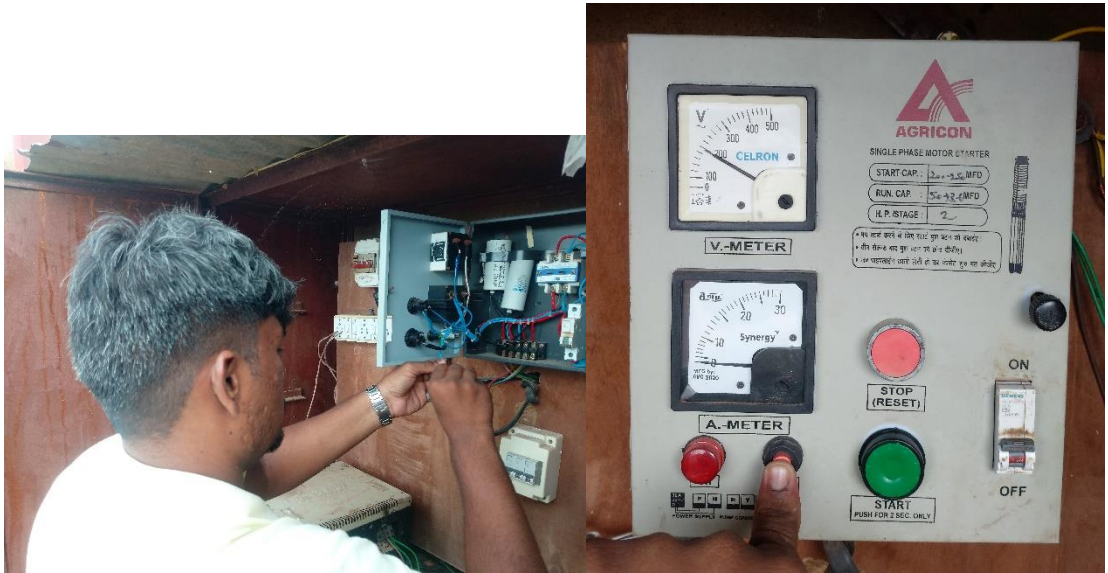

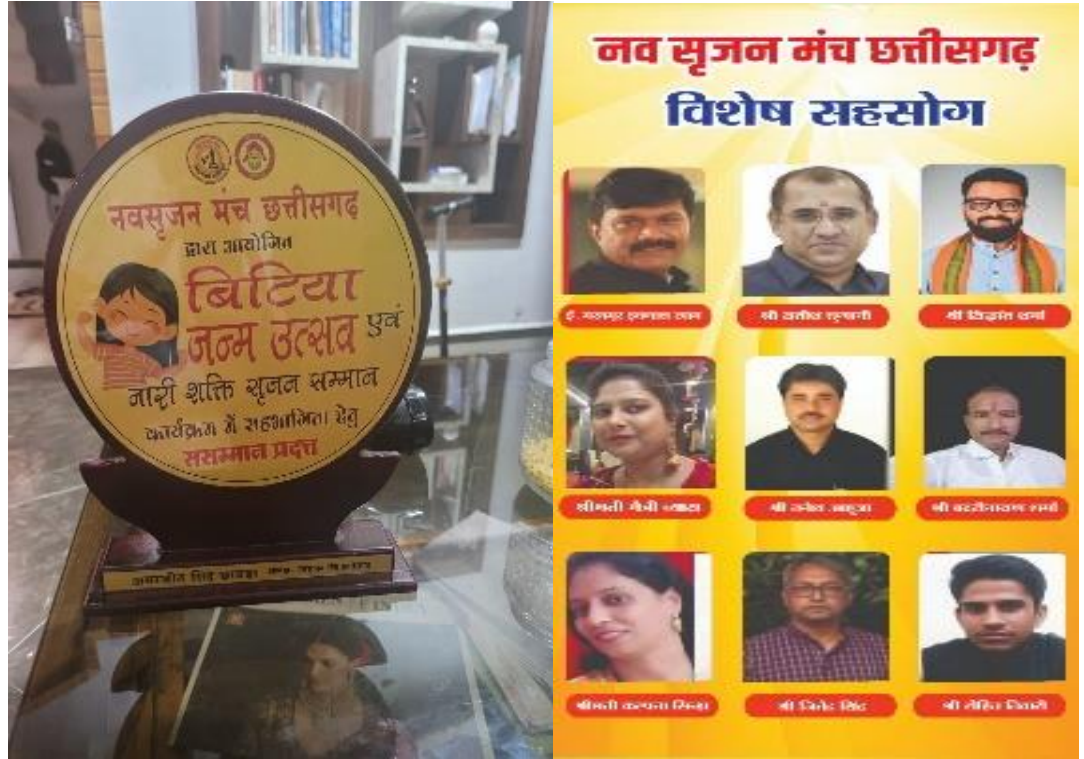
SMILE President Mr Jeetendra Singh and SMILE Field Officer Mr. Ansh Chinmay Singh were invited as trainers.
